We have had another great year with Unity North Outreach. One of the biggest ongoing projects we do is our once a month Family Table meal. This year was another successful year, we served over 1000 meals! Plus we have so much help - the YOU setup tables and chairs the night before, over twenty volunteers help cook, serve and wash dishes at each meal and then the men's group come in and help with the cleanup. It is a true team effort!

Another ongoing project we have is collecting eye glasses for a group called Project Safety Nets. This is one woman who travels to Senegal, Africa every year. She collects personal hygiene supplies, eye glasses and money. With the money, she buys malaria nets and gives them away with the other things. This year we gave 43 pairs of glasses. These go to people who have no other means of getting eye glasses.

- Stuffed animal give away to Mary's Place a homeless shelter in Minneapolis
