Starting in April, 2014, Carol Kniskern and Kathy Grimes began exploring different ways to build community about the healers. Together they identified 48 members who have participated at one time at Unity North as a Sunday or Wednesday healer. They agreed on the importance of bringing the healers together as a group for training and forming deeper connections between all the healers.

Starting in May, all 48 identified were invited to participate in Healer Gatherings. The purpose of these meetings is to offer training, form deeper connections with one another and have some form of prayer/healing experience.

Our Healer Gatherings are held on the months that we do not have Healing Sundays.

At our September Healer Gathering, our topic was changes are coming. Maybe you notice that we stopped offering healing on Wednesday night because people were not coming and the healers that were servicing on these nights wondered if there was another and better way of doing things. So after many discussions and thinking and decision was made to reboot our Wednesday recharge night.

Starting on Wednesday, November 19, 2014, 5pm – 7pm, we will begin what will be called Palal Experiences. Palal is an ancient Sanskrit word that means wonderfully made. As you know UNSC was founded with the intention of being a community of prayer, healing and joy. Our Palal Experiences will help refocus our attention back on this intention in a new way. These prayer/healing experiences will be held in our sanctuary and will be open to all to participate in.
